

Case Study



INDUSTRY

Food Processing Plant

PROBLEM

The plant was using both food-grade and non-food-grade lubricants onsite. Using both types of lubrication leads to increased stock holding of products/brands. Also the food-grade lubrication could be contaminated due to storage with non-food-grade range. Accidental use of wrong lubrication could occur due to incorrect product selection.



APPLICATION

General Plant Lubrication

SOLUTION

A site assessment was completed by BSC and 24 products were identified in the range. Using the Rocol range of products a product and brand rationalisation now reflects the Rocol brand only and a reduction from 9 brands plus a stock reduction of half the products from 24 to 12 products only.

BENEFIT

Simplification due to rationalisation of products and brands has reduced the overall stock holdings of lubrication for the plant. Compliance for audits has been made easier with the Rocol Care Program that provides Foodlube Statement, Allergen Statement, Microbial Resistance Statement and ISO 21469 approvals. Quality of lubricants helps to increase time interval between services and less overall use of product.
